

SCI Seeks Experienced Litigation Attorney

Safari Club International is looking for an attorney with 10+ (preferably) years of wildlife law litigation experience. This attorney will join SCI's Legal Advocacy and International Affairs Department and will work primarily on federal and state litigation involving hunting and the sustainable use management and conservation of wildlife. This is a full-time position in Washington, D.C. but it is possible for the attorney to telecommute from outside the D.C. area. The attorney will also assist with the drafting of comment letters on federal and state regulation, policy and resource management actions and will review, analyze and draft proposed federal and state legislation and regulation. In addition, the attorney will assist with the development and preparation of SCI's continuing legal education programs and will prepare materials and participate in SCI's advocacy-related committee meetings.
