## Waterfowl Working Group Action Items – March 2017

ACTION: Due to ongoing concerns about USFWS funding for the migratory bird program, the Bird Conservation Committee requests that the AFWA President send a letter to USFWS Director that conveys the benefits of the migratory bird program and requests that USFWS increase resources to implement migratory bird conservation across the country.

ACTION: The Bird Conservation Committee requests that the AFWA President send a letter to the Department Agriculture expressing the immediate urgency that NRCS take appropriate action to:

- Resume use of current, technically rigorous methods for wetland determination
- Ensure intent of Swampbuster is implemented and public benefits of wetlands are retained
- Provide a commitment to use appropriate data necessary to accurately delineate wetlands, consistent with the OIG report and the Congressional intent of Swampbuster provisions.

- 2. Resubmit Water Task Team proposal for 2018 North American session.
- 3. Watch and engage on WOTUS
- 4. Implement State Contributions Action Plan annual work plan with update at Sept. WWG meeting.
- 5. Work with Ed Penny to re-engage Federal Duck Stamp Task Force to activities outlined in the WWG annual work plan.
- 6. NRCS Wetland Conservation Provisions in the PPR Eric Lindstrom and John Devney will prepare a brief paragraph outlining the issue and the request from AFWA for Diane to bring forward to the BCC II meeting.
